What is PWA's Treatment Access Program?

PWA's Treatment Access program offers specialized case management that facilitates temporary short-term access to HIV medications while helping people gain long-term access to medical and drug coverage and has done so since 2004.

Who is the Treatment Access Program For?

The program assists anyone living with HIV/AIDS experiencing barriers to drug coverage, including refugees and immigrants in Ontario. This is one of PWA's programs that caters to people living with HIV/AIDS province wide.

The Treatment Access program has successfully helped 98% of the people served receive long-term drug coverage within six months of starting the program. The key to the program's success is the specialized case management that helps people manoeuvre the many complex government programs, including: Interim Federal Health, the Ontario Trillium Drug Plan and the ongoing support from the pharmaceutical companies who allow temporary access to HIV medications through their compassionate programs.
