In 1987, when PWA was created by three courageous people living with HIV/AIDS, the agency offered peer and practical support such as financial assistance (hence the name 'Foundation'). Over the years, the needs of our clients have changed and so did the way we deliver services. PWA's Essentials Market, access to medication, financial assistance, complementary therapies, social programming - these are just some of the ways in which we have assisted over 8,000 men, women, transmen, transwomen and children since 1987.

Since those early days, PWA's philosophy has remained the same, 'People living with HIV/AIDS are PWA's heart and soul'. This led us to fully integrating our client volunteers into our service delivery. In 2009, thanks to a bequest from the estate of John Max Pembleton, PWA had the opportunity to move into a bigger space at 200 Gerrard Street East at Sherbourne across from Allan Gardens Conservatory. This positioned us for expansion and augmentation of our services.

Today, PWA engages people living with HIV/AIDS in enhancing their health and wellbeing through practical and therapeutic support services and broader social change, and we inspire them to live into their dreams and discoveries.

Thank you for giving PWA the means to serve people living with HIV/AIDS in Toronto. We could not do it without YOU.

Announcing the Good Food Box

PWA's Essentials Market is pleased to announce the introduction of the Good Food Box from Food Share, a non-profit agency working to improve access to affordable and healthy food from field to table.


What is the Good Food Box?

The Good Food Box is a fee for service from Food Share. Food Share "buy[s] top quality fresh fruit and vegetables directly from farmers and from the Ontario Food Terminal, and volunteers pack it into green reusable boxes at [their] Field to Table warehouse. Volunteer co-ordinators [or agencies like PWA] collect money for the boxes in advance of delivery, then make sure that everyone gets their box after it arrives. [Food Share] delivers to daycares, apartment buildings, churchesanywhere there are 8-10 people who want to buy a box" (http://www.foodshare.net/goodfoodbox01.htm).

Why is PWA Offering the Good Food Box?

PWA decided to introduce the Good Food Box to help fulfill two of our strategic directions - to be a creative connector and health and wellbeing champion for people living with HIV/AIDS (PHAs). Offering the Good Food Box at PWA will connect PHAs to healthier, more affordable food which in turn will create more opportunities to improve health and wellbeing. To increase accessibility, PWA will be providing a \$5 subsidy towards the cost of the Good Food Box for PWA clients (subject to budget availability).

Sounds that Soothe - PWA's new integrated sound system

PWA would like to acknowledge a generous donation of sound equipment for PWA's board rooms which are utilized for clients' complimentary therapies, PWA and community partner meetings. The sound system has just been installed and we are now able to augment treatment sessions with gentle music to improve the restful and rejuvenating experience of clients by reducing ambient office noise. Clients have already reported that their experience in the improved treatment space is transformed. A 'Busy PWA office disappears' so that they can better enjoy a therapeutic and relaxing treatment.

The sound system has been installed in zones so that greater control is possible for when and where the music can play. This allows meetings divided by spacers to take place right next to therapeutic sessions without disruption.
