

July 27th, 2008 marked the departure of the 10th Annual Friends for Life Bike Rally – 315 committed cyclists and 108 dedicated crew members left Queen's Park and took to the roads of Eastern Ontario on a 6 day journey to Montreal. The cyclists and the support crew braved the heat, storms and heaps of mud to raise funds for the Toronto People With AIDS Foundation. All along the route mayors, residents of numerous towns and Scotiabank Employees came out to show their support. To a chorus of cheers it was announced at the arrival in Montreal that this year the Friends for Life Bike Rally exceeded the 2008 goal by raising \$1.2 million to support men, women and children living with HIV/AIDS in the greater Toronto area. All in all the 2008 Friends for Life Bike Rally was a tremendous success – A big thank you to all the riders, crew and sponsors for their partnership in this huge endeavour.
