



Poz Prevention Sexual Health Guidebook Project

A Survey for HIV Positive Gay Men

(... and People Who Provide Services to Them)

The Toronto People With AIDS Foundation has been funded the Ontario AIDS Bureau to develop a **pocket sexual health guidebook** for HIV positive gay men. This work is being undertaken in partnership with the AIDS Bureau's Ontario Gay Men's HIV Prevention Strategy. The sexual health guidebook will be released in late 2008 or early 2009.

The primary audience for the sexual health guidebook is **gay men living with HIV** (poz gay men). It will also provide important information to all gay men, and help gay men who are negative or who do not know their HIV status better understand issues facing HIV positive gay men.

Because the sexual health guidebook is intended to be concise and pocket-sized, it cannot include information on every aspect of sexual health for poz gay men. We need your help to determine what information the guidebook will include – the information that is most important to you.
